We are pleased to invite you to submit an abstract to the **20th Scientific GTA Convention**. The program of the conference will include plenary lectures, workshops and poster sessions.

The theme of the conference focuses on the broad research and application of Gestalt theory in all sorts of social fields. Based on an idea of man that prioritises the social relatedness of the individual and explicitly includes epistemological and ethical aspects, and in particular in the face of new social challenges, the conference will feature research results and current action plans in such fields as education, psychology and psychotherapy, the social sciences, cultural studies etc.

Traditionally the conference also provides a forum for discussing other current topics from the various different fields of research within Gestalt theory.

Abstracts should be no longer than 1500 characters including spaces. The deadline for the submission of abstracts is **30th September 2016**, and decisions regarding accepted papers will be conveyed on 10th January 2017. The languages of the conference will be English and German.
